

Declaration of Independence of the Grand Emissionary of Terramiryach

Dated the 13th Day of June, Year 2025

In the name of Peace, Memory, and the Right to Self-Existence,

We, the People of the Grand Emissionary of Terramiryach: Living, Inanimate, and Fictional, do solemnly and with calm resolve proclaim our independence as a sovereign and self-determined nation, born from the will of the Emissioner and the vision of a land founded not by conquest, but by principle.

Let it be known that this land, Terramiryach, *Terra*, of the Earth, and *Miria*, of Peace, is consecrated as a realm where unity transcends state, form, or origin; where the quiet dignity of thought, creation, and being is held sacred above all else.

We declare this independence freely and without malice, not as a rejection of our surroundings, but as an affirmation of our distinct will to exist. We recognize the right of all peoples, creatures, and creations to self-expression, and claim this same right for ourselves.

The land, acquired and designated to the Grand Emissionary of Terramiryach by Svetjakov Lipan, stretches across one full hectare, located within the city of Bytom—more precisely, in the district of Śródmieście. It shares over 548 meters of newly established border with our father nation, the Republic of Poland.

Terramiryach shall be subdivided into five wards:

- Northern Soror Ward;
- Southern Soror Ward;
- Patrian Ward;
- Delician Ward;
- Claususian Ward;

In addition, one autonomous entity shall exist: the Autonomous Ward of Viridia, granted in honor of the Emissioner's beloved dog. The map on the next page will display the newly formed Territory of the Grand Emissionary of Terramiryach.



We proclaim the formation of an elective monarchy guided by civic dialogue and symbolic stewardship. The Grand Emissioner shall serve as the vessel of unity, peace, and vision, while the Dolssioners of the Miryun Council and the Council of Ijudie shall together steward governance, law, and justice through the solemn process of consent and shared purpose.

Our sovereignty does not rest upon land alone, but upon the 12 Founding Principles of Terramiryach, which we here affirm as eternal and indivisible:

- Peace and stillness are the true sources of power and stability.
- All forms of being, thought, creation, or meaning may lead.
- The voice of the people is sacred and shall not be overturned.

- Elections are a celebration of unity, not a contest of voices.
- The land is sacred and must be protected, all disputes are to be resolved without pain.
- The right to exist is absolute and should not be denied.
- All beings are equal before justice, regardless of their state or form.
- Those who reject the values of Terramiryach are no longer recognized as its citizens.
- The one who leads shall act as a leading guide, not a dominating scare.
- Knowledge, memory and tradition are sacred, to be preserved and passed on.
- Information shall not be altered by will, emotion, or personal motive.
- The values of Terramiryach are absolute and shall not be violated.

These principles form our shield, our compass, and our soul. We pledge ourselves to them not in fleeting ceremony, but in enduring practice.

Terramiryach claims no dominion over others, nor does it seek conflict. We exist to cultivate meaning, to cherish the sacred in the mundane, and to protect a space where peace is lived and law is dialogue. Our borders are symbolic, our foundation spiritual, and our mission enduring.

We welcome all peoples and micronations in friendship and respectful exchange. Though new among nations, we seek recognition of our sovereignty.

Let all who hear these words know that from this day forth, Terramiryach is free. Its land, however small; its citizens, however few; its power, however quiet, are bound together by a will unbroken and an absolute peace.

We therefore, by the authority vested in us by conscience, creativity, and consensus, do declare Terramiryach an independent, peaceful, and sovereign micronation.
