The words listed on this document are all in present tense. To make verbs past tense, add 'id' if the present tense word ends in a consonant and 'd' if it ends in a vowel. The verb is conjugated first before the 'id' or 'd' is added.

To make someone possess, add an apostrophe and then a z if it ends in a vowel. For example, to say 'Luca's', you would write 'Luca'z'. If you want to make something that ends in a consonant possessive, add an apostrophe and then 'iz'. For example, 'Lucas's' is 'Lucas'iz'.

The suffix 'er' in Trogolnese is 'ur'. For example, when saying eater, you would say 'apiur'. The suffix 'ic' in Trogolnese is 'aic'.

To make a verb into a gerund, (to turn run into running) add an 'an' if it ends in a consonant and 'nan' if it ends in a vowel.
