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To whom it may concern...

The 2026 MicroWiki@Discord General Survey was a community survey published on June 1, 2026, which lasted till July 1, 2026. It recorded various demographic data as well as approval ratings in various intermicronational organizations that primarily operate in the virtual realm. This is the ICSB's first public community survey. It yielded a total of 24 responses. The survey was published on the main page of the micronations.wiki website, and within the MicroWiki community Discord server.

Demographic Data Analysis

What is your age range?

The majority of survey participants (62.5%) fall into the 18–26 age group, followed by 25.0% in the 14–17 age bracket and 12.5% in the 27–40 category.

What is your race?

A large majority of respondents identified as White or Caucasian (66.7%), with the remaining participants reporting diverse backgrounds including Mixed, Middle Eastern, Belarusian, Asian, multiracial (Caucasian/Hispanic/Native American), and non-standard entries.

What is your sex?

The vast majority of respondents identified as male by birth sex (83.3%), while 8.3% identified as biologically intersex, 4.2% as female, and 4.2% preferred not to disclose.

What is your gender orientation?

Cisgender represents the primary gender orientation among participants at 79.2%, with single responses reported for transgender, detransitioned, non-applicable, and open-text entries.

**What is your sexuality?**

Heterosexuality is the most common sexual orientation among participants at 58.3%, followed by Bisexual (16.7%), with individual responses for Homosexual, Asexual, Pansexual, and combination or non-standard answers making up the remaining 25.0%.

What sector do you claim to "reside in"?

Discord emerged as the primary platform sector at 37.5%, followed by MicroWiki at 25.0%, physical/in-person operation at 20.8%, and independent websites or webpages at 12.5%.

Additional Data Analysis**Why do you participate in micronationalism?**

Participants listed varied motivations, with recurring themes focused on community building, political simulation, personal recreation, world-building, and exploring alternative societal models.

What is the most important aspect for aspiring micronations?

Respondents highlighted active community engagement, clear purpose and identity, persistence and commitment, and avoiding superficial execution as key elements for success.

Do you support the Intermicronational Census & Survey Bureau?

Exactly half of all respondents (50.0%) expressed support for the Intermicronational Census & Survey Bureau, while 41.7% abstained or were unsure, and 8.3% opposed it.

Do you support the Micronational Olympic Federation?

The Micronational Olympic Federation received strong backing, with 70.8% of respondents in support, 20.8% abstaining or unsure, and 8.3% opposed.

Do you support the Institute of Micropatriological Research?

A solid majority of participants (54.2%) supported the Institute of Micropatriological Research, while 37.5% abstained or were undecided, and 8.3% expressed opposition.

Do you support the Grand Unified Micronational?

Opinions on the Grand Unified Micronational were highly divided: 37.5% expressed support, 33.3% opposed it, and 29.2% abstained or remained undecided.

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
