Whereas,

It is desirable that the style and attribute of *Royal Highness* and the titular dignity of *Prince* and *Princess* be prefixed to the first given name of each person so titled.

Whereas,

It is desirable that, when used as a spoken or written form of address, the style and attribute of *Royal Highness* take the form of *Your Royal Highness*, and in plural, *Your Royal Highnesses*.

Whereas,

It is desirable that, when used as a third-person reference, the style and attribute of *Royal Highness* take the gender-specific form of *His* or *Her Royal Highness*, and in plural, *Their Royal Highnesses*.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the grandparents of His Majesty King Matthew forever hold the style and attribute of *Royal Highness* and the titular dignity of *Prince* and *Princess*.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the father of His Majesty King Matthew forever hold the style and attribute of *Royal Highness* and the titular dignity of *Prince*.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the siblings of His Majesty King Matthew forever hold the style and attribute of *Royal Highness* and the titular dignity of *Prince* and *Princess*.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the nieces and nephews of His Majesty King Matthew forever hold the style and attribute of *Royal Highness* and the titular dignity of *Prince* and *Princess*.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the husband of current and past Queens Regnant forever hold the style and attribute of *Royal Highness* and the titular dignity of *Prince*.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the children of current and past monarchs forever hold the style and attribute of *Royal Highness* and the titular dignity of *Prince* and *Princess*.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the grandchildren of current and past monarchs forever hold the style and attribute of *Royal Highness* and the titular dignity of *Prince* and *Princess*.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the great-grandchildren of current and past monarchs forever hold the style and attribute of *Royal Highness* and the titular dignity of *Prince* and *Princess*.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the spouses of those who are so titled forever hold the style and attribute of *Royal Highness* by virtue of marriage.

Whereas,

It is desirable that this Royal Decree be referred to in all legal documents as the *Royal Titles Decree of 2026*, or otherwise referred to as RD-2026-018.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the Great Seal be affixed to this Royal Decree upon the signature of His Majesty The King.
