SUBJECT: Establishment of the National University of Versmark

WHEREAS the Department is charged to establish a post-secondary institution for the purpose of offering degrees in Versmarkian law, political science, and degrees in the fields of national defence, as stated by the 3rd edition of the National Ministry Directive;

WHEREAS the Constitution of the Sovereign State of Versmark §4.4 grants Directors the ability to make decisions and policy in their sectors of administration;

BE IT RESOLVED that the National University of Versmark is formally established as an educational institution within the jurisdiction of the Sovereign State of Versmark; and,

BE IT RESOLVED that the National University shall be directly governed by the Director of Education as its Chancellor, who alongside his or her Department will coordinate with the appropriate authorities and Ministries to direct the establishment, and implementation of, degrees relating to the aforementioned fields, alongside other possible fields of study; and,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Director shall be free to establish various positions below the rank of Chancellor that will assist him or her in the operation of the National University; and;

BE IT RESOLVED that the National University shall be comprised of various colleges underneath it dedicated to the study of the liberal arts, the study of Versmarkian law, and for research as needed from the National University; and that each of these colleges are to be headed by a Dean appointed by the Chancellor; and,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Education is directed to issue a report surrounding the following fields of interest with respect to the National University of Versmark: creating curricula with the cooperation of other Ministries and authorities; the potential implementation of a “core curriculum” for all students; methods of accepting new students; and the accreditation & composition of various degrees that will, and may be, offered at the National University; and,

BE IT RESOLVED that in the Director’s position as Chancellor, and for the time being, the National University shall incorporate the standing Law Practitioner’s Course as the course



of study required to obtain a Juris Doctor (JD) degree, and thus shall retroactively confer this degree to all students that have completed the Course in full.
