

Treaty of Alliance and Mutual Recognition

Between the EMPIRE OF LEVINIA and the KINGDOM OF LANDOPIA

Whereof:

HIS IMPERIAL AND MOST ILLUSTRIOUS MAJESTY THE EMPEROR OF LEVINIA; and
HIS MAJESTY THE KING OF LANDOPIA

HAVE RESOLVED TO FORMALIZE AND ADVANCE THEIR RELATIONS AND TO THIS
END have designated as their plenipotentiaries the following:

FOR LEVINIA:

His Imperial and Illustrious Majesty BENJAMIN I, Emperor of Levinia, etc. etc.
etc.

FOR LANDOPIA:

His Majesty CARLO I, King of Landopia, Lord of Insua Maiestatis etc. etc. etc.

Who publish and proclaim the following:

Article 1: Parties

The two states involved in this treaty are the Empire of Levinia, referred to within as “Levinia”, and the Kingdom of Landopia, referred to within as “Landopia”. When meaning both, the states will be referred to within as “parties”.

Article 2: Principles

2.1 The parties have agreed to develop friendly relations of cooperation in respect to the principles of mutual respect for sovereignty and territorial integrity, mutual non-aggression, non-interference in each other's internal affairs; unless formally asked, and peaceful coexistence.

Article 3: Recognition

3.1. The parties agree to formally recognize each other as sovereign nations with full diplomatic relations.

3.2. Recognition encompasses respect for the territorial integrity, political independence, and right to self-determination of each party.

Article 4: Territorial Integrity

4.1 Neither party will make recognition of any state that claims the territory of the other party.

4.2 If a party recognizes any other state that claims the territory of the other party, the slighted party may seek nullification in accordance with Article 9.2 if the other party is unwilling to revoke recognition of the conflicting state.

Article 5: Non-Aggression

5.1 The parties shall not commit acts of violence or aggression against each other, either individually or jointly with any other state. If such an act takes place, direct communication on diplomatic channels shall be initiated to negotiate and discuss the issue. During such a period, this Treaty shall be temporarily suspended until hostilities are resolved.

Article 6: Mutual Security and Defense

6.1 The parties acknowledge the importance of regional and global security and commit to consultation and collaboration on matters affecting their mutual security interests.

6.2. In case of external threats, the parties may consider joint defense measures in accordance with international law.

Article 7: Communication

7.1 The parties will make a persistent and continued effort to communicate with each other and explore venues of cooperation while this treaty is in effect.

7.2 The following actions or events need to be communicated forthwith to the other party within two (2) weeks or fourteen (14) days:

- (1) Changes in Head of Government or Head of State
- (2) Changes in status of sovereignty
- (3) Changes in diplomatic policy

Article 8: Dispute Resolution

8.1 Disputes arising from the interpretation or application of this Treaty shall be resolved amicably through diplomatic means or, if necessary, through agreed-upon international mechanisms.

Article 9: Nullification

9.1 Both parties have the unilateral authority to nullify this treaty for any reason, especially including reasons regarding failure to follow the provisions in this treaty.

9.2 When a party seeks to nullify this treaty they will notify the other party of the nullification after which a period of one week or seven (7) days will begin during which this treaty will be suspended. If both parties agree then this action may be reverted and this treaty will be unsuspended. This period may be used to prepare for the nullification or seek to prevent it but after this period expires this treaty will be nullified.

Article 10: Ratification

10.1 This treaty will be ratified when both parties have completed all necessary steps to allow ratification and when all plenipotentiaries affix their signatures to this document below.
