

Hindering the President from Abusing Judicial Powers to defy the constitution

Section 1: NBPI.

- (a) The National Bureau of Presidential Investigation or NBPI will be founded. The NBPI job is to investigate whether the president is abusing judicial powers given to the president.
- (b) The current president gets to suggest a new president where the parliament can vote on whether to do a presidential election or elect the suggested one.
- (c) The president gets to choose who to be the director of the NBPI.
 - (i) But if the director of the NBPI does not investigate the president ever, parliament can hold a vote and if the majority agrees, the current director is removed from their position.
 - (ii) If the current director is removed, the parliament gets to decide who shall be the director. The parliament gets to have multiple candidates to vote on and will continue voting until one is appointed.

Section 2: How. If the president is abusing judicial powers the NBPI gets to remove the current president from their position if the majority of parliament votes to do so.

Section 3: Why. The reason for this executive order is to make sure that the president can't abuse their judicial power given to them in the constitution.
