Whereas,

It is desirable that we codify the Titles and Peerages reserved for and granted to the Heir Apparent to the Throne of the Realm.

Whereas,

It is desirable that these Titles and Peerages be granted only to the eldest biological child of the Monarch born within the bounds of Holy Matrimony.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the Title of *Prince of Rogemore* be granted to the Heir Apparent to the Throne of the Realm at the pleasure of the Monarch by Letters Patent.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the Peerage of *Duke of Woodside* be automatically inherited by the Heir Apparent to the Throne of the Realm.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the Peerage of *Earl of Crescent Lake* be automatically inherited by the Heir Apparent to the Throne of the Realm.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the Peerage of *Baron Moondragon* be automatically inherited by the Heir Apparent to the Throne of the Realm.

Whereas,

It is desirable that this Royal Decree be referred to in all legal documents as the *Prince of Rogemore Decree of 2026*, or otherwise referred to as *RD-2026-004*.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the Great Seal be affixed to this Royal Decree upon the signature of His Majesty The King.

Whereas,
RD-2024-001 was issued on August 29, 2024, establishing a Constitutional Convention and appointing delegates to that body.

Whereas,
RD-2024-002 was issued on August 30, 2024, appointing additional delegates to the aforementioned Constitutional Convention.

It is desirable that RD-2024-001 and RD-2024-002 be repealed and declared null and void.

It is desirable that the Great Seal be affixed to this Royal Decree upon the signature of His Majesty The King.

By Royal Decree,

Whereas,

The Constitutional Convention established by RD-2024-001 and further amended by RD-2024-002 has been repealed by RD-2026-005 and declared null and void.

Whereas,

It is desirable that we form a new body to write a formal Constitution, a frame of government, which shall lay forth the fundamental principles and ordinances according to which the Realm is to be governed and administered.

Whereas,

It is desirable that we call this body *The Royal Constitutional Commission*.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the Monarch serve as Chair of this Royal Commission.

Whereas,

It is desirable that we appoint *The Right Honorable The Baron Douangaphaivong* to be a member of this Royal Commission.

Whereas,

It is desirable that we appoint *His Royal Highness The Duke of Granite Rock* to be a member of this Royal Commission.

Whereas,

It is desirable that we appoint *The Honorable Countess of Pine Meadow* to be a member of this Royal Commission.

Whereas,

It is desirable that we appoint *The Honorable Countess of Zinnford* to be a member of this Royal Commission.

Whereas,

It is desirable that we appoint *The Honorable Baron Holmes* to be a member of this Royal Commission.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the persons appointed to this Royal Commission meet regularly to counsel and deliberate together until the Constitution is completed and ratified.

Whereas,

It is desirable that this Royal Decree be referred to in all legal documents as the *Royal Constitutional Commission Decree of 2026*, or otherwise referred to as RD-2026-006.

Whereas,

It is desirable that the Great Seal be affixed to this Royal Decree upon the signature of His Majesty The King.
