

An Act making government appropriations for Q3 of fiscal year 2026

TITLE I

SECTION 1. EXECUTIVE BRANCH SPENDING, ETC.

- (a) The president heading the executive branch will be allowed to allocate the following to various operations of their discretion of these branches of the executive for Q3,
- (1) with the president’s discretionary spending is allowed to be spent as the president sees fit:

\$1,450.....	Ministry of Labor
\$1,300.....	Ministry of Environment
\$1,000.....	Åland Space Technological Administration
\$1,000.....	Presidential discretionary to others

- (b) Defense spending for the Åland Defense Forces will have significant spending allocated to it for Q3,
- (1) with the president being commander-in-chief, discretionary spending (allocated above) is as well allowed to be spent on the Åland Defense Forces as the president sees fit,
- (2) although the president is not allowed to spend funds allocated or appropriated to specifically defined allocations:

\$2,500.....	Rocket development & production
\$1,000.....	Firearm development & production

- (c) The president is to be authorized, as according to this law, to search for viable revenue streams for the budget, in Q4, using allocated discretionary spending.
- (d) The president will not be given a wage, due to the current president as of this bill being a member of parliament as well, thus wage is already included below under Section 2 (a).
- (e) The Sovereign State of Åland Postal Service will be allocated \$50 for Q3.
- (f) Law enforcement will be allocated \$100 for Q3.

SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE BRANCH SPENDING, ETC.

- (a) For parliamentary members of the parliament, wages will be defined within this appropriations bill as \$1,000 for the rest of Q3, to all parliamentary members.

- (b) Extraneous provisions, i.e. irrelevant, can not be included within future appropriations bills, which count as bills allocating spending. Irrelevant means that it is a provision which is not related to spending in any way,
 - (1) although taxation and appropriations rules will still be allowed to be modified and or added within future appropriation bills.
- (c) The Parliamentary Budget Office is to be allocated \$100 for Q3.
- (d) The Government Treasury is to be allocated \$100 for Q3.

SECTION 3. INFRASTRUCTURE SPENDING, ETC

- (a) For infrastructure and development, spending will be allocated to such for Q3, with the job of the president to properly allocate these appropriations to contractors or executive branch agencies,
 - (1) for minerals surveying and extraction, funds will be allocated to the strategic materials of lithium, cobalt, copper, and nickel:

\$450.....	Minerals surveying and extraction
\$300.....	Shipbuilding

- (b) The Åland Minerals Spending Oversight Commission will be established, or ÅMSOC for short,
 - (1) ÅMSOC will review contractors, if chosen, and will oversee their operations to make sure they comply with any rules the Ministry of Environment or president have explicitly ordered.
 - (2) ÅMSOC will be under the oversight of the executive branch, specifically under the Ministry of Environment.
 - (3) ÅMSOC is to be allocated \$100 for Q3.
