

DECLARATION OF THE BIRTH OF THE NATION OF CALESIA

We, a people whose hearts hold nothing but honesty,

DO HEREBY PROCLAIM
this day, September 14th, 2025,

the birth of our rightful Nation, and we give it the name of Calesia.

The circumstances that gave rise to the recent events in the world, and the prevailing distrust towards the present state of affairs, have led us to reconsider our vision of humanity. Without denying the other nations and existing states, we deem necessary the birth of a Nation not founded upon earthly borders—forever the object of contention—but upon the conscience and the capacities present within each of us.

We believe in goodness and in beauty; thus, the idea of a Nation of humanity, reminding us that we are far more alike than we perceive, appears to us as a bastion of trust in a divided world.

We wish to establish a permanent stronghold within our minds: a Nation rooted in our conscience, in the sentiment of a universal citizenship that knows no barriers.

Convinced of the vanity of earthly possessions, we believe in a Nation that lives within human beings.

This Nation does not arise upon bare soil, but is born of the conscience of kindred minds.

There it finds its dwelling, and from there its government arises.

There shall be no land in this world that it will ever seek to govern.

We shall plant our flag upon the water.

This is not an act of conquest, but of renunciation.

Like water, it shall embrace every shore without possessing any.

The waters upon which our flag shall rest will flow and mingle with other waters, so that none may ever say: "Here, here lies Calesia."

As testimony to our Nation there shall be only the bare word, born of the conscience of the citizens of the world.

Calesia does not aspire to eternity. Its very existence is bound to the necessity that has brought it forth.

It exists so long as the world requires a reminder that humanity comes before borders, and that fear cannot rule us.

When that day comes, Calesia shall dissolve as a deed fulfilled.

And in the collective memory, its intent shall remain.

FOUNDATIONAL PROVISIONS

We acknowledge, and raise to the rank of Supreme Charter, the *Universal Declaration of Human Rights*, adopted in Paris on December 10th, 1948.

The *Declaration of the Birth* constitutes the fundamental law of our Nation; other Charters shall be added thereafter, forming together the founding body of Calesia.

The Founding Citizens of Calesia establish a Provisional Government entrusted, within six months, with the task of organizing the operative structure of the Nation, spreading the idea of our Nation, and ultimately presenting Calesia to the world.

On Accession

The citizenship of Calesia is open to all who feel part of something greater, who understand the importance of uniting all humanity, who commit themselves to live without fear, and who wish to contribute actively to the spread of justice.

Such citizenship shall not affect nor prejudice any other citizenship the person may hold and entails no fiscal obligations, legal constraints or claims.

Citizenship shall not be acquired by descent: every adherence is a personal and conscious act.

On Acts

The acts issued by Calesia are distinguished into two fundamental categories:

The Laws

These concern the internal organization of the Nation, the management of registries, of citizens, of institutions, and of international relations. They are gathered in the Code of Laws.

The Works

These are acts of philosophical, moral, and universal nature, addressed to all humanity and not solely to the citizens of Calesia.

Their purpose is to preserve and spread the sentiment of justice, to promote the dignity of the human being, and to awaken the collective conscience. They propose, they do not impose. They are gathered in the Corpus of Works, accessible to all, thereby becoming part of the universal cultural heritage.

On the Mission

Our aim is to inspire the peoples of the world and to demonstrate the possibility of a life more just and more human.

Calesia sets its supreme mission in humanitarian aid: reaching the most remote places, supporting the farthest communities, acting within the concreteness of their lives.

Our purpose is to inform the world, to develop a global knowledge—free and humanitarian—open to all and belonging to each.

APPEAL TO ALL PEOPLE

With this final appeal, we address all who may wish to hear our voice.

The Earth is vast: billions of people speak thousands of languages, living within hundreds of different States.

And yet, the world is greater than the reality that surrounds us. May we go beyond.

May we recognize ourselves not as citizens of a State, but as citizens of the world itself, united by the sole sentiment of humanity.

To all who feel they belong to something greater, we ask that they echo our voice.

So that together we may help those who live in fear, unable to rise within a world corrupted and torn apart.

Believing in a Homeland for all humanity, we entrust this Nation to the world today,
in the hope of contributing to a better future.
